Guidelines

Eligibility and Selection Criteria: The Internal Auditor of the Year is awarded to one Internal Auditor to recognize leadership, exceptional achievement in business **or** significant contribution to the internal audit community, including a desire to work with others to foster lifelong learning.

To be eligible for the award, the nominee must be a member of the Detroit Chapter of the IIA and have demonstrated **any of the following**:

1. Internal Audit leadership in their position, industry, community, etc;
2. Support of IIA standards and compliance with the IIA code of conduct;
3. Commitment and clear contributions to the professional practice of Internal Auditing (IA);
4. Outstanding impact in the execution of their role as an internal auditor;
5. Active involvement in support of the community;
6. Support and/or advocacy of the importance of lifelong learning;
7. Involvement in Internal Audit thought leadership initiatives and/or innovation.
