Scholarship requirements

Be a student member of the Institute of Internal Auditors in good standing-having attended at least 1 meeting during the 2015-2016 year.

Must be currently enrolled as a college/university student (minimum part-time) during the 2015-2016 school year.

Include one reference from a professor and one from a professional

Write a 1000 word essay on one of the topics noted below.

Essay Topics

- 1) As an association, one of the challenges we face is getting a millennium generation more engaged and involved. What technology and/or innovation initiatives should be used to advanced young leadership within the internal audit profession?*
- 2) The concepts of risk management, governance, and effective controls impact a company's overall health and ability to implement strategy to meet performance targets. How can the Internal Audit function help companies more fully achieve these strategic objectives?*
- 3) One of The IIA's strategic initiatives is Advocacy of the profession. What does Advocacy mean to you and how should advocacy initiatives be prioritized by the IIA to provide the greatest impact?*

The Academic Relations committee will vote on the winning essays.
